

## **Lisanne van Beek**

Lisanne van Beek is Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Advisor at CBI, the Centre for the Promotion of Imports from developing countries. CBI is part of the Netherlands Enterprise Agency (RVO) and commissioned by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Netherlands. Ms van Beek is Co-Chair of the Donor Committee for Enterprise Development (DCED) Women's Economic Empowerment Working Group.

From 2016 to 2021 (January), she was CBI Programme Manager responsible for multiple projects, including a coffee project in Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama. The aim of this EU-funded project is to help 25 coffee SMEs and cooperatives to become competitive on the European market. She combined this with the position of Gender Coordinator.

In 2015, Ms van Beek worked at the Economic Affairs section of the Permanent Mission of the Kingdom of the Netherlands to the United Nations and other international organisations in Geneva. In 2014, she worked as Project Advisor for public-private partnership facilities including the Facility for Sustainable Entrepreneurship and Food Security of the Netherlands Enterprise Agency. In 2013, she worked as Project Officer at CBI.
