

# Anne-Kathrin Röthemeyer

Anne-Kathrin Röthemeyer is Head of the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises (NCP) Division at the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy since 2020. Priorly, she had been German National Contact Point for the NCP since 2019.

From 2015 to 2019, she was desk officer responsible for the World Trade Organisation at the Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Germany to the United Nations and other international organisations, in Geneva.

From 2012 to 2015, she was Desk officer at the Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy and was responsible for general trade policy issues.

From 2011 to 2012 she worked at the Permanent Representation of the Federal Republic of Germany to the European Union, in Brussels. As Desk officer, she was responsible for policy, transatlantic relations, in particular Latin America.

She worked at the Federal Ministry of Economics and Technology from 2008 to 2011, where she was Deputy head of the minister's office. Priorly, she was Deputy head of the press division at the same institution.

From, 2006 to 2007 she was Desk officer responsible for postal policy, nuclear policy, and economic statistics at the Permanent Representation of the Federal Republic of Germany to the European Union.

In her career, she had also worked as Directorate-General for Trade and Services at the European Commission, Desk officer responsible for the construction industry at the Federal Ministry of Economics and Technology, and Desk officer at the Ministry for Urban Development, Housing, Culture and Sports of North Rhine-Westphalia.
