

## Progress so far

---

- 11 Meetings held to date
- **Sharing Information:** Continuing sharing best practices, including sharing and joining with other TWSs
  - Presentations by FNC, Fairtrade, Hanns R. Nuemann Stiftung, IDH, GIZ, Promecafe, RA, IACO, CI
- **Establish Benchmarks:** Continuing to work with ICO producing countries to establish and approve benchmarks. Peru, Mexico & Indonesia are main focus, but other updates can be seen in Annex.
- Advance **resource mobilization** process focused on meeting the commitments and supporting PPPs to close income gaps, develop data systems to inform strategies based on LPI, production costs; value transfer (FOB-FG) and resilient landscapes.
- Secured **funding for regional facilitation** (Promecafe & IACO) and for TWS facilitation and coordination (until July 2023)

**Linkage with Other TWS:** Active collaboration with TWS 2&4 on coordination of activities, outreach, fundraising, and M+E. Participation in TWS3 to build linkages with eventual commitments.

**Sector Coordination Needs:** Continued coordination, e.g. collective view of Fundraising needs and donor approaches across the TWSs, TF Roadmap M+E framework (in progress), outreach to wider ICO members for engagement in TWS processes e.g. benchmarks

## Progress to date

---

- ✓ Resolved to pursue 2 focal areas: Cost of Production and Price Transmission Efficiency
- ✓ Determined that origin have sovereignty of their data and that, at an aggregate level, it could be shared, in-country and also via ICO for learning
- ✓ COSA created a basic approach, work plan, and budgets and drafted a full proposal
- ✓ ICO Council approved proposal
- ✓ Proposal discussed with funder

## Next steps

---

- Final approval to secure external funding
- Identify pilot countries & Technical Panel
- Strengthen working linkages with other TWS
- Collaboratively refine methods and approaches
- Build capacity of national coffee bodies to gather and manage data to int'l standard
- Review findings with Advisory Panel, pilot countries, TWS, and ICO

## Progress so far

---

- Process to select potential landscapes, including criteria to identify interested countries – agreed and approved
- Mapping/Inventory of ongoing efforts: work in progress to develop a template with landscape initiatives and understand interest across the public and the private sector.
- Proposal submitted to GIZ for €130,000 to undertake initial LandScale assessments as first step in building landscape approach
- TW members and leads reviewed (call Oct 27) and contributed to TW1 LPI on proposal for strategy to lay foundation for PPPs

### Linkage with Other TWS:

- Close coordination and alignment with TW1 LPI criteria for PPPs and Pilots for the process and criteria for country and landscape selection, for outreach and fundraising.
- Gender: active engagement and inclusion of women, youth and marginalized groups as a key element within a gender transformative approach included in the conditions + commitment of interested target countries.

## Next steps

---

- Webinar with SOS Mata Atlantica and Nestlé involving coffee consumption and reforestation in Brazil
- Country/Landscape selection for LandScale assessments
- Further increase alignments across workstreams and with place-based investments initiatives by partner initiatives (e.g. SCC, GCP, GEF FOLUR, 1000 Landscapes), including to secure co-funding

- Overall framework approved by CPPTF, but metrics need further work

### TWS Coordination:

- TWS Coordination meetings fully functional, will be extended even further given need for detailed in-country implementation

- 130<sup>th</sup> ICC session approved TW1-2-4 proposals
- India admitted as new member to Task Force

### Gender integration

- Transformative strategies Proposal signed off by Sector Coordination group- now to be actioned across TWS and TF

- Ongoing input and advice provided to support TWS to embed and strengthen gender elements of proposals and implementations plans in development.

- Development of Gender-Transformative Marker to provide public and private sector Task Force members with a practical tool to assess and strengthen the gender perspective of their activities and practices across the coffee value chain.
- Compile and share final report of learnings and recommendations to support embedding gender in the next implementation phase of the ICO Task Force Roadmap.
